State Testing

After Spring Break all grade 6-8 students will be taking the ELA and Math State Assessments. Eighth graders will also be taking the Science State Assessment. The tests are not timed. We know that an end-of-the-year test cannot possibly tell us everything about your child's academic progress. However, the results do act as a snapshot of your child's strengths and areas for improvement and can be used as a way to ensure he or she is getting the support he or she needs.
